#### JEWELLERY

For reasons of safety and security, jewellery is limited to a small stud in each ear and a watch. Any other form of piercing - lips, noses, tongues, navels etc. are **not acceptable.** All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons. Piercings **cannot** be covered with a plaster for PE so if a student cannot remove a piercing they will **NOT** be allowed to do PE and a sanction for this will be issued in most cases.

#### HAIR Hair sh

Hair should be a natural colour and the style should be appropriate to a business-like working environment. No tramlines, patterned styles, dual colours, hair extensions. Different lengths causing visible lines are not allowed. Aerosols/Hairspray must not be brought into school.

No makeup in years 7 - 11. Light make-up is permitted in the Sixth Form. No extreme colour nail varnish or nail extensions.



## **Uniform Matters**

## Years 7-13

## **Netherthorpe School**

Netherthorpe believes that it important for students to maintain high standards of school dress and to take pride in their appearance. All students in Years are expected to wear the following...

**Blazer -** plain black with House Badge (badge can be bought separately).



**Tie -** Clip on Netherthorpe tie, Sixth form tie for Post 16.

**Shirt -** White, with collar (must be tucked in).

**Trousers -** Plain black school trouser - no jeans, brushed denim, patch pockets, hipsters, lycra, jeggings, drainpipe trousers, no zips or splits down the side, no leggings, no tracksuit bottoms.

**Jumper** - Optional, Black V-necked, must be worn under the blazer and not instead of the blazer. Cardigans are **not** allowed.

Tights - Plain , black or natural.

**Footwear -** Plain all black footwear offering suitable protection in laboratories or workshops. Black sensible boots may be worn under school trousers. No trainers or sports makes with coloured logos on, canvas plimsolls, UGG boots or Dr Marten style boots. Maximum height 2" or 5cm.

**Outdoor Coat -** Must be suitable to wear over a blazer. Should be suitable for cold and/or wet weather. No hoodies, or denim jackets.

**Accessories** - <u>Scarves</u> may only be worn with an outdoor coat. <u>Hats</u> must not be worn around school.

**Skirt -** Straight black or pleated -**Knee length with school logo** (must be purchased from the school supplier).

**Shorts**— Plain black tailored shorts, knee length. No sports shorts or lycra shorts.
