We recommend that most students choose 3 subjects from the 4 blocks. All applicants should see our prospectus recommendations on which route into Sixth Form we advise.

You can only choose one subject from each option block. If you are only doing 3 subjects then one of your option blocks below will be empty.

If you wish to do the Level 3 course in Health and Social Care there are two versions of this course. A single option (1 A Level equivalent) and a 3 option version (equivalent to 3 A' levels).

The 3 option version will span all of the option blocks so will be the only choice you need to make.

## **Advice and guidance**

Our options are divided for 5 main subject areas STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths), Creative, Humanities, Languages, and Social Sciences. These groups of subjects are there for students to consider what combinations students are undertaking and if they combine to suit the direction may be seeking. These groups are;

### **STEM Subjects**

Maths, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Further Maths, Computing, Food & Nutrition, DT – Product Design, Design Engineering,

### **Creative Subjects**

Drama, Media Studies, Art and Music.

### **Humanities**

History and Geography.

### **Language Subjects**

English, English Literature, French and Spanish.

### **Social Sciences**

PE, Sport, Health and Social Care, Business, Sociology, Psychology
