Home – School Agreement

for the phased reopening of schools from Monday 15th June 2020

By sending our child into school you are confirming that you agree to the following:

I/we agree that as parents/carers, we will do our best to:

- Ensure that our son/daughter arrives at school punctually for the designated start time
- Discuss the process of returning to school with them and ensure they are clear about the reasons for social distancing and the need to maintain 2m from others at all times
- Inform the school if our son/daughter will not be attending on their designated day
- Not send our son/daughter in if they exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19 and have them tested if needed, ensuring that school are kept fully informed
- Ensure that our son/daughter come appropriately dressed for school
- Ensure that our son/daughter gets to and from school in a safe way
- Collect our son/daughter as soon as possible if requested to do so by the school
- Not send our child to school if they are unfit to return during this time and fall into either the clinically extremely vulnerable or clinically vulnerable category
- Not send our child to school if someone in the household is shielding or will be placed at risk if our child returns to school

I/we understand that if our son/daughter does not follow the rules outlined above, or they put the health and safety of others at risk, then they are likely to be sent home and may not be allowed to return for the remainder of the term.

As a student, I will do my best to:

- Arrive at school on time and follow the markers when waiting to enter the site
- Sanitise my hands on entry to the school, entry to the classroom and exit from the classroom, before and after eating, after going to the toilet, on leaving the school and when asked to do so
- Use a tissue if I need to cough or sneeze and wash or sanitise my hands afterwards. Cough or sneeze into my elbow if I don't have a tissue.
- Maintain social distancing and keep 2m apart from other people at all times, including on the way to and from school
- Sit at my allocated desk and not walk around the classroom or go near anyone else's desk.
- Use only the equipment on my desk and not loan anything to or from anyone else
- Follow instructions from staff at all times
- Follow the markers and one-way system when moving around site
- Inform a member of staff straight away if I feel ill
- Follow the school code of behaviour and the mobile phone policy.

I understand that if I do not follow the rules outlined above, or I put the health and safety of others at risk, then I am likely to be sent home and may not be allowed to return for the remainder of the term.
