



JEWELLERY

For reasons of safety and security, jewellery is limited to a small stud in each ear and a watch. Any other form of piercing - lips, noses, tongues, navels etc. are **not acceptable**. All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons. Earrings must be covered with a suitable plaster provided by parents, for 6 weeks following initial piercing if they cannot be removed. After the 6 week period, earrings should be removed for PE lessons.



HAIR

Hair should be a natural colour and the style should be appropriate to a business-like working environment. No tramlines, patterned styles, dual colours, hair extensions. Different lengths causing visible lines are not allowed. Aerosols/Hairspray must not be brought into school.



Make-up

No makeup in years 7 - 11. Light make-up is permitted in the Sixth Form. No extreme colour nail varnish or nail extensions.

Netherthorpe believes that it important for students to maintain high standards of school dress and to take pride in their appearance. All students in Years are expected to wear the following...

BOYS

Blazer - plain black with House Badge (badge can be bought separately).

Tie - Clip on Netherthorpe tie, Sixth form tie for Post 16.

Shirt - White, with collar (must be tucked in).

Trousers - Plain black school trouser - no jeans, brushed denim, patch pockets, hipsters, lycra, jeggings, drainpipe trousers, no zips or splits down the side.

Belt - Plain black, no large buckles

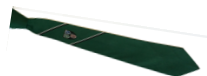
Jumper - Optional, Black V-necked, must be worn under the blazer and not instead of the blazer. Cardigans are **not** allowed.

Socks - Grey or black.

Footwear - Plain all black hard wearing school shoes offering suitable protection in laboratories or workshops. Black sensible boots may be worn under school trousers. No trainers, sports brands, canvas plimsolls.

Outdoor Coat - Must be suitable to wear over a blazer. Should be suitable for cold and/or wet weather. No hoodies, or denim jackets.

Accessories - Scarves may only be worn with an outdoor coat. Hats must not be worn around school.



GIRLS

Blazer - plain black with House Badge (badge can be bought separately).

Tie - Clip on Netherthorpe tie, Sixth form tie for Post 16.

Shirt - White, with collar (must be tucked in).

Trousers - Plain black school trouser - no jeans, brushed denim, patch pockets, hipsters, lycra, jeggings, drainpipe trousers, no zips or splits down the side.

Skirt - Straight black or pleated - **Knee length with school logo** (must be purchased from the school supplier).

Belt - Plain black, no large buckles

Jumper - Optional, Black V-necked, must be worn under the blazer and not instead of the blazer. Cardigans are **not** allowed.

Tights - Plain , black or natural.

Socks - Grey or black.

Footwear - Plain all black hard wearing school shoes offering suitable protection in laboratories or workshops. No sandals, trainers, sports brands, canvas, plimsolls. Maximum height 2" or 5cm. Black sensible boots may be worn under school trousers.

Outdoor Coat - Must be suitable to wear over a blazer. Should be suitable for cold and/or wet weather. No hoodies or denim jackets.

Accessories - Scarves may only be worn with an outdoor coat. Hats must not be worn around school.



Students who are not dressed according to the Uniform Policy are likely to be sent home to change before being allowed to lessons. Students not wearing the correct footwear will be expected to borrow a pair from the Isolation Room, these are treated with a hygienic spray between uses.
