What is a bursary?

A bursary is paid by school from a special grant we receive.

What a bursary is for?

A bursary is money that you can use to pay for things like:

- clothing, books and other equipment for your course
- transport and lunch on days you study

Priority	Criteria	Entitlement
High	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students who are in care or have just left care and are living independently.• Students receiving income support in their own name.• Disabled students who are receiving both the Employment Support Allowance and the Disability Living Allowance	Bursary Payment - 6 payments of £200 paid every six school weeks. (Duration 36 school weeks)
Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students who are registered for free school meals.	Bursary Payment - 6 payments of T.B.A paid every six school weeks. (Duration 36 school weeks)
Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students whose household income is less than £25,000 per year.	Bursary Payment - may apply for part or full reimbursement of course related costs. (Duration 36 school weeks)
